**Footnotes**

BELLA'S FELLA set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then shook away late in the stretch under a brisk drive. BUSTER ROSE pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and had nothing left in the stretch run. LIVERMAN tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. ZUMVATA stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. FRANS DEPUTY broke awkwardly from the gate, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. TURN TONY TURN was on the inside into the turn and steadily faded. DE ELEGANT CAT broke slowly from the gate and was no factor. GET HOLME LARRY was done early. SCATTERFIELD was through after a half. HOOSIER HOOTIE showed little.
