VETERAN'S DAY chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. STRONG CLUE was well placed early, while on the inside into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. OLD RING vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. PRIME SPEED pressed the pace early from between horses, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. INDISCREET AFFAIR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then remained clear in the stretch but faltered late. UNDER LIKE THUNDER was settled off the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch run. SUGAR'S T BONE was never a threat. KETTLE CORN was never involved. SMART ATTIRE was done early. SILENCE N MOTION was always outrun.
