PAVARENDA was well placed early then steadied along the backstretch, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and won the head nod at the wire. BACKSIDE SALLY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch and was out-nodded at the wire. LADY MONAVI stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. EVEN IN APRIL pressed the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. THE SKY IS FALLING angled off the rail into the turn while no threat. KATIE DANCING vied for the lead early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. DOITFORBOB checked in the turn. A BENE C trailed the field throughout.
