### Footnotes

TEXAS HOLDEM JOE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn three wide, stayed three wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive, took command in late stretch and drew away in the end. BUDGET BARGAIN was five wide on the first turn then settled on the run down the backstretch, rallied then swung out to be eight wide in upper stretch, closed well in late stretch to be up for the place. COULD BE MICHAEL was allowed to settle then rallied on the far turn four wide, moved out to be five wide for the stretch drive and closed willingly in late stretch but was no menace. COMPLACENCY dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive on the far turn to mid stretch then weakened in late stretch. SIR VICE ROY was in tight entering the first turn and shuffled back, was settled while stalking the pace three wide on the backstretch, made a bid three wide entering the far turn to gained command in mid stretch but tired in late stretch. ABSOLUTELY GOOD was allowed to settled while racing inside into the far turn then was no menace in the stretch drive. LIL POSH dueled for the early lead while inside, was hard used then faltered in the stretch. LOOKS LIKE A SAINT raced four wide on the backstretch and failed to menace. ISTAN'S FURY was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the backstretch then faltered. MINE THAT GUN raced six wide into the first turn then dropped back on the run down the backstretch and far turn then was distanced in the stretch.
