CRAFTY OAK was unhurried early, rallied, saved ground, gamely, won driving. IM OUT FIRST had good early speed, inside, but was outfinished. CRYSTAL MINE was void of early speed, rallied, flattened out. HIGHFALUTIN dueled, 3 wide, then gave way. FIRST FLYER was void of early speed, passed tiring rivals, was no factor. OUT BY NOON was well placed, no rally. QUIET FUN flashed brief speed, was through after a half, stopped.
