Footnotes

MOON RULER set the pace on the rail, gained a clear lead at the five sixteenth pole, drew off through the stretch, driving. GOOD WILL EXPRESS pressed the pace from between rivals, duelled through the turn, gained in the stretch drifting in but could not threaten the winner. BALLACOLLA second flight and four wide, bid four wide at the quarter pole, drifted in through the stretch and had a mild gain to be best of the rest. ZYGLOW chased the pace off the rail, gained a striking position at the quarter pole, flattened out through the stretch. MISTER HOBBLER chased the pace on the rail, steadied for racing room into the turn, dropped back, then had no rally. MAKE A WAY void of speed, improved his position on the outside. SERENITY TRAIL stalked the pace three wide, duelled through the turn, hung. HOOSIER REDNECK was never involved. TUFF LITTLE B five wide in the early going, drifted wider for the stretch run, then had no rally. KITE FALCON well placed in the early going, had no rally.
