MOONSHINE STILL mid pack and off the rail, waited while blocked through the turn, split rivals once in the stretch and closed well to edged ahead in a game effort the final strides. OUR LUCKY SOX well placed and off the rail, moved up three wide through the turn, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain to have a short lead at the eighth pole and missed between rivals. R. P. INDY mid pack and three wide, gained a striking position through the turn, bid five wide into the stretch and hung, outside. HURRY HOME WARREN tracked the early pace off the rail while angling outrun, challenged through the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened the final strides. LATIN NOTE passed a tiring rival. DOCALOT set the early pace off the rail, turned back a challenged into the stretch, stayed on when challenged again and faded the final sixteenth. LOW GAP improved his position. HEISWHATHEIS showed little. VERY CLEAR was never involved. FLAT OUT RICH moved up quickly inside, raced boxed through the turn, was blocked into the stretch, then had no rally.
