ALDORABLE DEBBIE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. BLOCK WATCH was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn then moved up in the stretch while no match for the winner. OUTBURST chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and improved position. LAURYN'S SAY was well placed early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. PADRONA tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch run. GERI GERI GERI was through after a half. WYNN'S DECISION was never a threat. ORACABESSA was done early. DISTINCTIVE DANCER showed little. KIRKLE CAFE was never involved.
