JAYDEE was unhurried early while racing on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then swung out to be three wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and drew away and held sway in the end. BRENT THE BANKER was unhurried early while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn then was gaining ground while five wide in the stretch and finished well in the end. I SEE A SHARK raced on the inside on the run down the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn while staying inside, continued along the rail in the stretch to late stretch but hung in the end. MABEE STORMY was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn three wide, angled out to be five wide for the stretch drive and was gaining ground but came up short in the end. DIAMOND DANGO raced two wide on the backstretch then rallied three wide on the far turn but flattened out in late stretch. LIGHTNING JACK dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then faltered in mid stretch. STEVIE RAY BURGER was allowed to settled while racing three wide, made a bid three wide on the turn then flattened out in the drive. LAST STAMP dueled for the lead while two wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch.
