ICE CUBE DIAMOND set the pace off the rail, drew clear into the stretch, lasted under steady handling. AIRO MAGIC tracked the pace off the rail, bid three wide into the stretch, move up through the lane, hung. BEST INTENTIONS tracked the pace on the rail, came through inside of rivals at the quarter pole, flattened out. LOST RIVERS CUPID mid pack and outside, moved up four wide through the turn, came five wide to bid into the stretch, then could not gain in the late going. ANNIE'S LUCKY STAR stalked the early pace outside, bid three wide into the stretch, dueled with a rival through the stretch, weakened. PERPETUATE broke out and bumped a rival at the start, bore out through out. KATELYN GIRL well placed and outside, came four wide to bid into the stretch, dueled through the lane, faded. LIL' MISS LILLY was no factor. COMING HOME sent from the gate, shortened her stride and was outrun.
