Footnotes

PROS N CONS set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, drew off in the stretch while ridden out to the wire. MISS ZIGGY was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. BANK CANDY stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. CHAMPAGNE LASS chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch run. PRINCESS PULL was back early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. BOLD PEAKS angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. DAVY'S CAT was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late in the stretch. RED LIQUOR N' LACE broke thru the gate in the pre-start. GRANT'S KAYLA was never involved. EXPLOSIVE IMPACT trailed the field throughout.
