Footnotes

NORWAR dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn then shook clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. LEGOLAS was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn with a late gain in the stretch and was up for place in the final stages. COMMANDER BULL chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn with some late gain in the stretch drive. SOLOMON'S FLAG broke out at the start, angled into the three path in the far turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. LAST RIDE COWBOY led the field early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch. GUILTYGUILTYGUILTY dueled early, while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch. SEA FIGHTER was never a threat. SERENASGO was bumped at the start while no factor. CANE SWAGGER steadied in the far turn. FED UP had brief speed then folded up.
