### Footnotes

MISS ZEVA was allowed to settle then rallied on the turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and powered to the front in deep stretch. ZARCH was three wide into the turn, rallied in the middle of the turn then swung out to be five wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground and finished well to be second best. QUEEN BRITT was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be seven wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground but was too late. BLONDE BULLET was allowed to settle while inside, saved ground on the turn then rallied along the rail in mid stretch, slipped through and made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. BERRY FLASHY dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but weakened in late stretch. DO ME A SOLID dueled for the lead while inside, drew off on the turn while being hard used then weakened in late stretch. START STREET was well placed while racing three wide into the turn, made a strong bid in upper stretch to late stretch but came up empty in the end. VIRGINIA AND TONIC was unhurried early and no factor in the stretch. WILDCAT JILLEE raced four wide into the turn, was used up then gave way in the stretch drive. KITTENISH raced on the inside and lacked a rally in the stretch.
