Footnotes

BEG MEL chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. HAARMAN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but yielded late. BRASS BOLT tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. UNLOOSENED BIT was well placed early, while on the inside into the turn and lacked any late gain in the stretch drive. SPURTABILITY stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. SOLON EXPRESS bobbled at the start and was no threat. OLD SMOOTHIE was done early. ARROSON showed little. MOCC ME NOW was never involved. CHOW WAGON was always outrun.
