RAPID SURVIVOR void of speed, circled the field through the second turn, came widest into the stretch and drove clear under mild urging. DR. JASPER stalked the early pace inside, challenged for and gained a short lead through the second turn, gained a clear lead in the stretch and was outfinished. LIL CON MAN set the early pace well off the rail, could not go with DR. JASPER into the stretch, stayed on to hold the show safe. SHORT SALE well back and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and got up for a share. MAJOR POINT passed tiring rivals. NEW YORK GIN well placed and outside, held position to the final furlong and faded. CROWN'S BIG DAY showed little, inside. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP was a brief factor, inside.
