PLATINUM BLUE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a steady drive. PURPLE JEAN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then faltered late in the stretch while second best. FROSTING swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. MEMAWS BABY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch run. HOOSIER STEPS angled into the four path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch, vanned off after race. WHATA HOOSIER was done early. OFF BALANCE had early speed then folded up. WHAT A DANCER eased in the stretch.
