BASIN BANANNIE stalked the pace three wide, took command at the three eighth pole, angled to the rail in the stretch and drew off, driving. LINDA'S LACE well back and off the rail, angled out around the turn, then fanned seven wide into the stretch, closed well but could not threaten the winner. PRINCESS COMPOSER rated mid pack and on the rail, angled out through the turn, fanned six wide for the stretch run, then was not good enough while drifting in. EASY TEE void of speed and off the rail in the early going, angled to the rail in the turn, closed willing on that path through the stretch. BREAN CAN chased the pace off the rail, angled out through the turn, bid, angled to the rail in the stretch and flattened out. MAGGIE SLEW well placed and three wide in the early going, bid on that same path at the three eighth pole, gained a striking position entering the stretch, then had no rally. MORO TRAINO was never involved. GLITTERING JUSTICE pressed the pace on the outside, dueled through the turn, faded in the lane. WHATSITGONNATAKE set the early pace on the rail, dueled through the turn, stopped.
