Footnotes

FATHER JOHN rated between horses, advanced three wide on the bend, was bumped and forced out nearing the three-sixteenths pole, quickly recovered to gain the lead near the sixteenth marker then was urged clear. MR. MINK was quickly clear, set the pace inside, no match for his stablemate in the deep stretch but lasted for the place. LAZ HAS RISEN forward placed inside, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, came again from inside through the stretch, was boxed in and steadied briefly inside the last sixteenth and altered out nearing the wire. PASS PROTECT chased MR. MINK from just outside, drifted out nearing the three-sixteenths, bumped hard with FATHER ART, was soon corrected and slowly wore down in the late going. UNLOOSENED BIT void of speed, saved ground through the bend, lodged a mild bid just off the rail in the stretch but hung the last furlong. FATHER ART in midpack early just outside FATHER ART, was four wide on the turn and lacked a stretch bid. LIEPERS FORK was angled out early on, three to five wide through the bend, drifted out upper stretch and had little to offer. ALAGNAK in contention between horses, backed up just off the rail on the turn, swung out to path four entering the stretch and continued to give way. VIC'S REBEL soon trailed, angled in entering the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track into the stretch and was empty.
