PLEASANT AS PAIGE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, took over in the stretch and cleared late under a steady drive. EMILY D. was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. OH MY DI was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. BULLY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. ROYAL SPITFIRE angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. LIL BRIT chased the pace early while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch. FLAMING I. D. raced up close early, steadied in the turn, angled off the rail inside the quarter pole and was tired in the stretch. THIEF IN THE NIGHT bobbed at the start and trailed the field throughout.
