STONE RUNNER tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and edged clear late. FOR SPACIOUS SKIES vied early while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but did not have enough late. EASYBABY was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. SAILORS PASTTIME was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and improved position late. PEACEPHILLY chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. ONE LADY'S VICE dueled early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch. STING IN THE TAIL was done early. BELLE STARR eased to the wire and vanned off.
