LIEPERS FORK was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field in the final stages. MO FASTER tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command and drew clear in the stretch but yielded late. RARE POWER trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. NEED MONEY DAD chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn but lacked a late bid in the stretch run. JACKS ARE LUCKY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. FATHER ART angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. SOLD OUT angled into the five path in turn and steadily faded. SIR DAKOTA was through after a half. BRASS BOLT was done early. CHECK IN ADVANCE had brief speed then retreated.
