Footnotes

HOOSIER EQUAL broke a step slowly from the gate, gained a striking position three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain, dueled the final furlong and edged ahead in the final strides. JANES WONDER BUG well placed and three wide, moved up to challenge through the turn, edged ahead between calls in the stretch, then dueled with the winner and was outfinished. TWO STASH well back and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RED WHISPER stalked the early pace from between rivals, moved up to challenge through the turn, then weakened the final furlong. SINGING CHAMP set the early pace off the rail, dueled through the turn, then faded the final furlong. RECONCILED improved his position. ROAD POET ran evenly. DIVINEMERCYSUNDAY tracked the early pace inside and was through after a half. M J QUEBE was never involved. SEARCH THE LOU was no factor.
