Footnotes

SHAFTED chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leaders and cleared the field in the final stages. PUBLISH trailed the field early, angled into the four path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch and was up for place late. HERO HEART pressed the pace early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn then led in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. HOLY ARMENIA was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. WILL E SCAT swung into the six path in the turn and improved position. SHOT OF KELA vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. HONOR MATTERS was never a threat. SAUCY'S GOT IT set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. TEEBERRY was through after a half. NIMO had early speed then folded up. HERO HEART WAS DISQUALIFIED FOR MEDICATION VIOLATION.
