CROWN'S BIG DAY stalked the early pace three wide, headed the pace setter through the turn, came three wide to bid into the lane, drove clear at the eight pole, held. HATCHET JACK well back and outside, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, made a steady gain in the lane and got up for the place late while no threat to the winner. CAMINANTE sent from the gate to vie for the early lead from between rivals, dueled through the turn with the early pace setter, shook clear of that one, could not go with the winner in the lane and weakened in the drive. MARCOS TRACKER broke out at the start, was well back and on the rail, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, drifted in in mid stretch and got up for a share. MORO GUSTO tracked the early pace off the rail, then had no stretch rally. FERDIE'S GUY second flight and three wide, bid four wide into the lane, then had no rally. POPS IS TOPS tracked the early pace from between rivals, faltered. DRAKE'S DANCER set the early pace inside, dueled through the turn, coasted through the lane. GOLD DIGGIN GROOM was always outrun.
