Footnotes

LITTLE GRINDSTONE was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn, angled out inside the three sixteenth pole then drove past the leader and cleared the field late. RAPID SURVIVOR was back early, angled into the three path in the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch while no match for the winner in the final stages. SUNSET ARTISAN tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. EL GRAN DAN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, remained clear in the stretch but gave way in the final stages. RUNNING TAB stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but faded late in the drive. MAJOR POINT was through after a half. SIR PRESLEY angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. SIR NASTY was never involved. ROOF TINNER was done early.
