Footnotes

PURELY AMATURE tracked the early pace inside, angled out into the stretch to bid three wide, dueled with NICKERS FOR CANDY to the eighth pole, shook clear of that one, drew off while being kept to the task. NICKERS FOR CANDY stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenged through the second turn, dueled with the winner to the eighth pole and stayed on to be best of the rest while no match for the winner. THE DUCK OF REED mid pack and on the rail, gained position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then lacked the needed final kick. LAST STAMP set a pressured pace on the inside, drifted out in the stretch and tired. BETONAWINNER six wide through the first turn, was mid pack and outside, moved up quickly three wide, then bid four wide into the stretch and flattened out. MUCHACHO ALEGRE improved his position. GLADIATOR'S SWORD showed little. HEZA WINNER TOO was a brief factor. DIAMOND DANGO was never involved. GOTTA GETCHA ONE was outrun.
