Footnotes

HATTAASH mid pack and outside, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then drove clear late. BAHIM set the pace inside while pulling, stayed on through the lane and held the place safe. NO FLATTERY NEEDED moved up quickly down the backstretch inside, raced boxed through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then could not gain the final furlong. THOMAS J well placed and outside, bid five wide into the stretch, then ran evenly in the lane. FIRST GOLD vied for the early lead outside and faded after a half. MR. REALISTIC improved his position on the rail. STORMY OCEAN mid pack and between rivals, moved to a striking position quickly, then had no rally. JUSTAMATTEROFTIME was a brief factor, inside. METEOR STREAK was never involved.
