WESLINN sent to the lead from the gate, dueled with rivals through the turn, shook clear in the stretch, drew off while being kept to the task. DISCREET STREET mid pack and between rivals, gained contention through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, made a steady gain and got up for the place late. STOLEN CHEVY tracked the early pace under a hold, pulled to contention into the turn, dueled, then lacked the needed late response. OAK RICH mid pack and on the rail, came through inside of rivals at the quarter pole, closed willingly to get up for a share. TOURISMO improved his position. CRIMSON PRINCE showed little. ALL ON THE LION mid pack and outside, was forced out around a breaking down rival. CITIZEN vied for the early lead inside, dueled through the turn, faded in the lane. PRICELESS BULL broke down.
