Footnotes

HATCHET JACK set the pace early while being pressured, angled off the rail into the turn then shook clear in the stretch run and held in the final stages. ISLE OF WRIGHT was unhurried early then was forced wide and swung into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. ONETWENTYONE TRACK vied early while four wide, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. HAIL TO MR. LEADER pressed the pace early from the inside, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. STEPPIN AHEAD angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. TWO PENS KEN dueled early from between horses, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. CHARLIE'S PASSION was never involved. P B ODON was through after a half. JAYDEE broke slowly from the gate and was outrun.
