REALLY STORMY was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn then angled to the inside in the stretch and came thru the rail while clearing the field in the final stages. GREAT RISK was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. UNDER LIKE THUNDER tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. CLASS CLOWN stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. BAD BRAD was far back early, angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. WATCH ROCK angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. MISTER MONSIEUR was on the inside into the far turn and faded late. ITALIAN EXPRESS set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way readily in the stretch. MI VIERA was never involved. ULTIMATE SILENCE was done early.
