NICKELWOOD was allowed to settled then rallied heading into the far turn, was three wide in the middle of the far turn and in a strong drive, gained command in mid stretch then drew away in the end. FLASHAHOLIC dueled for the early lead while inside, was in a long sustained drive then drew off on the far turn but weakened in late stretch and held the place safe in the end. EBEN ALSAFA stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faded in the stretch drive. FAWNING was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid then raced evenly in the stretch and was no menace. SPOOKY SPIRIT was unhurried early then was on the inside on the far turn, raced evenly in the stretch and was no threat. BENEVOLENT DESPOT was unhurried early on then raced four wide on the far turn and was no menace in the stretch drive. TOUR THE PLACE was allowed to settled then lacked a rally. SWIFT BABY SLEW was outrun in the early going and was no threat. MORMON METEOR was outrun throughout. ROJO CIELO dueled for the early lead while two wide, was hard used then stopped to a walk in the stretch drive.
