Footnotes

MIGHTY PATRIOT sped clear soon after the break, made all the pace out from the rail and held a safe margin while roused through midstretch then was put to a hand ride in the final sixteenth. TWIST N STROLL tracked the pace from along the inside, continued on willingly up the rail to gain the place but could not endanger the winner. ISLE OF TUNES tracked the winner from along the inside to late in the turn, angled outside that one for the drive and could not save the place in the late going. WHO FIRED WHO raced in good striking position while three wide but lacked a closing response. WOBINANN came in heading up the backstretch to force a rival in and cause congestion, continued to angle to the inside through the turn but lacked a rally. LAURA'S WIN was bumped heading up the backstretch when TIA SESA was forced in, tracked the pace from three wide and failed to threaten. FEISTY FLIRT bobbled at the start and lacked early speed while outside, swung seven wide into the stretch and moved up while not a threat. LULU'S WAY was always back racing outside. TIA SESA was bumped when put in tight quarters heading up the backstretch and squeezed back then never reached contention. ZOPIC tired while four to five wide on the turn.
