SENIOR RAIN chased the pace early from the inside, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a steady drive. PASS THE CROWN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. THISAIN'TMYDAY trailed the field early, while on the inside into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. BAREFOOT BANDIT stalked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and faded late in the stretch run. POINT FINISH angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. GRAND TRAVERSE bobbled at the start, angled into the three path in the turn. GOLD FOR CASH swung into the six path in the turn and steadily faded. WITH REVENGE was through after a half. KELA'S BOY had early speed then folded up. TOE TAPPIN TEDDY had brief speed then retreated.
