STAKES Indiana Futurity Black Type - Thoroughbred

(INCLUDES UP TO \$42,000 ITDF) FOR TWO YEAR OLD REGISTERED INDIANA BREDS, COLTS AND GELDINGS PREFERED.

By subscription of \$50 each, which shall accompany the nomination \$200 to pass the entry box and \$100 additional to start, with \$84,000 added. Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee \$840 which includes entry and starting fees. After paying 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, the remaining purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs; of one race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs; maidens, 8 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be given to (1) Colts and Geldings; (2) High weights (sex allowances considered); (3) Highest earnings will then be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The entry fee will be refunded if a horse fails to draw into the race. (S)

DREAD THE PIRATE stalked the pace while racing on the inside down the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then angled out in upper stretch to be three wide, was forced out in mid stretch while in a strong drive and drew off in the end. SEAL BEACH was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide, made a strong bid in late stretch but was only second best. SHORT ROUND dueled for the early lead while two wide, was in a long drive and gamely dug in throughout the stretch but weakened in late stretch. CLYDE PARK bore out on the first turn off heels then was settled, started a run coming out of the far turn then angled out to be six wide and closed ground willingly in late stretch but was too late. INDIANA CHARLIE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. BIRD OF PRAISE dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long

drive while being used up and gave way in the stretch drive. JOINT TENANT was unhurried early then failed to menace throughout. HOLD ON LOOSELY unhurried early then failed to menace. RUNAWAY RAJ was allowed to settle in the early going while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a middle move on the far turn then gave way in the stretch. PAINTED VALLEY was allowed to settled then faltered on the far turn. THANK YOU KISSES was unhurried early then was no factor. HUNK A PIE was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
