**Footnotes**

PRETTY LILLY advanced to a stalking position while angling to the rail in the opening quarter, raced unhurried to midway through the turn, steadily closed the gap on the pacesetter leaving the bend while switching just outside that foe, wrested command in mid stretch and gamely held the late challenge of MISSTRESS under some right handed encouragement. The latter tracked the pace along the inside while unhurried through the backstretch, advanced between foes on the turn to challenge the top pair, came through tight quarters in the lane to draw on terms with the winner but proved second best in the drive. ADINA'S STAR sped clear and angled sharply to the rail midway through the backstretch, opened a commanding margin into the turn but faltered in upper stretch. PIZZAZZ tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, raced just outside the winner to the lane, swung out four wide entering the stretch but couldn't sustain that effort in the final stages. WHAT'SUPWITHTHAT bumped at the start by DEBUTANTE DANCER, was under pressure to gain contention racing between foes but couldn't make any serious progress. BONNIE AND HOWARD tracked the pace inside foes to the lane and never gained a contending position. SIBLING SONG raced six wide into the stretch and never threatened. DEBUTANTE DANCER broke inwards, bumped a rival at the start, was forced in soon after by MY SISTER KATE, made a brief effort racing five wide on the backstretch but soon faded. MY SISTER KATE bore in at the break, bumped a rival, was taken in hand and angled to the inside, but never menaced thereafter. CARSON CAN CAN chased the pacesetter while outside foes into the turn, drifted out midway through the bend and quickly gave way. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF MISSTRESS LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
