SHELAGHS LITTLE JO had good early speed, saved ground, drew off, won driving. SHE STOOD ALONE was well placed, rallied, but failed to sustain a bid, and was second best. BE A ZIA TOO was void of early speed, had a mild rally late. JUNGLE BONNET was well placed, had a mild rally, bid,hung. ALI'S GAL stalked the pace, ran evenly with no rally. DOWNTOWN SAVANNAH had good early speed, was through after a half, then dropped back. FOOLISH ILLUSION was no threat, passed tiring rivals. VIGGY'S MISSY was no factor, had no excuse. TIME FOR A GALLY had good early speed inside, was through after a half, stopped. GENTLE PROSPECT had brief speed, then stopped.
