SONOMA SUNSET unhurried early, rallied into the stretch, assumed command and drew clear in a steady drive. A CHANCE TO PASS well placed, rallied three wide to the lead in the stretch but was outfinished in the drive. HY MAUREEN no speed for a half, went four wide around the final turn but with no late gain through the stretch. CONTE N ME unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and moved up late. MOSTLY MAGICAL stalked the leader for a half, took over after three quarters but faltered in the drive. BABY GIRL MALIA broke in at the start and was never a menace. DEVILISH CANDY set the pace for three quarters and stopped readily. SPANAKOPITTA bumped at the start, chased from inside and gave way through the stretch.
