### Footnotes

O'CHARLIE never far back with a four wide rally into the stretch, drew clear through the lane under mild urging. SLICK TOWN MONKEY had no speed to the stretch, rallied to close the gap late while no match for the winner. THOUGHT I COULD never far back, inside to turn with no late gain through the stretch. PL'SHARD KNOT inside to stretch, caught in tight at the furlong pole, bumped soundly with no late bid. ITSA HOLIDAY good speed to duel for a half and gave way readily. CHIPS A BOY failed to menace. MORO PROSPECTOR broke in the air, rushed to vie three wide and weakened in the stretch while bumped late. OAK RICH vied between horses, was squeezed out and steadied while in tight at the three eighths pole then pulled up in the stretch in distress and subsequently vanned off.
