PAGE'S LEGACY vied for the lead inside, dueled with PAGE'S LEGACY through the turn and into the stretch, inched ahead at the eighth pole, prevailed under steady handling. SOLD OUT fractious in the gate, broke sharply to set a contested pace on the outside, dueled with the winner through the turn and into the stretch, weakened the last furlong but held the place safe. THE CASSTOWN CAT fractious in the gate, tracked the pace inside, drifted out in the stretch run, came again in upper stretch to hold the show. JUST WATCHME SARAH trailed the field in the early going, gained position through the turn to bid three wide into the stretch, angled in in the lane for clear racing room and missed the show late. WEST ON WALLSTREET tracked the pace on the outside, bid four wide into the stretch, then could not mount a serious challenge. DR. BLUE GROOM showed little outside. ITSA HOLIDAY showed little inside. HONKY TONK GOLD broke sharply from the gate, bucked after start and was no factor. SKY AND ELI fractious in the gate, gained position into the stretch, then had no rally.
