MERITAGE was unhurried early, had a mild rally, late. THISONEFORME stalked the pace, ran evenly with no rally. WINNING REQUEST dueled, saved ground, then weakened. EL SHE was well placed, had a mild rally and weakened. OVERNIGHT EXPRESS showed good early speed, then gave way. JASPER MAN dueled 3 wide, then stopped.
