TEE STAIN vied for the lead early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and just got up in the final strides. UP IN THE BRIDLE dueled early, angled off the rail in the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. OUR ACCIPITER tracked the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. EQUINE BEAUTY raced up close early, angled into the four path in the turn with some gain in the stretch. DARK NEMESIS dueled early, angled off the rail in the turn and gave way in the stretch. MY FRIEND JIM was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with a minor gain late. GOBAIN angled off the rail in the turn and was no threat late. SPURTABILITY stumbled at the start and was no factor late. ARCHAIC was unruly in the gate and done early.
