Footnotes

PUNCH BAG moved four wide on the turn, angled six wide into the stretch and closed with a strong late run to collar QUAD BYPASS in the closing yards and be moving clear. QUAD BYPASS dueled from outside SPEEDY MEDIA through the turn to edge clear in midstretch then could not hold the winner safe. SPEEDY MEDIA dueled from inside QUAD BYPASS to midstretch, could not go with that one late but dug in to hold third. MAMA'S LIL' MON stalked the leaders while three and four wide on the turn and could not produce the needed late bid. CUB'S POWER was three wide through the turn and could not produce a final closing response. EECCHHOO lacked a rally racing two to three wide. NIGHT WING saved ground and was not a factor. GROOVY BANDIT showed speed from inside the early leaders and tired. BROWNEYED HANSUMAN broke awkwardly and was always back racing four wide. HUMBLEVICTOR was not a factor racing three wide.
