DECISION MAKER set the pace, angled off the rail into the first turn, angled three wide into the far turn then drew clear at the quarter pole under a steady drive. COLOR ME LOVE was unhurried early, angled four wide into the turns then rallied in the stretch but was too late. SUSAN'S SONG tracked the leader from the outside, angled three wide into the turns and weakened in the drive. MALIBU RUN lacked speed early, angled five wide into the first turn, fanned widest into the lane and moved up. STEEL LASS was well placed early, angled four wide into the turns with no rally. ZEALOUS RUNNER stalked the leader, angled off the rail into the turns and faded. MISSISSAUGAS MAGIC pressed the pace while saving ground in the turns and stopped. MOST CHARISMATIC was never involved.
