SALTY N SASSY showed in front at the break and showed a good turn of early speed to move clear through the turn, drew off under urging through midstretch then was put to a hand ride in the closing sixteenth. MISSING JACKIE rallied inside to move clear for the place but could not menace the winner. CRAZY DEBUTANTE tracked the pace from three and four wide on the turn and had little left. PUDDLES PLEASURE moved up three wide but was no threat to the top ones. SECOND SHIFT chased the pace from two or three wide and tired. EASTER TRYST tired from along the inside. DARING JULIE tired from four wide. JESSICA CAT saved ground and was not a factor. BOSTON STORM showed speed from six wide to the turn, gave way and was eased late.
