FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$50 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$100,000 added, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 121 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$30,000 at one mile or over in 2004 5 lbs.; of \$21,000 at any distance in 2004 7 lbs.; of \$15,000 in 2004 9 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or starter races not considered). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing (72 Hour Closing). Trophy to the winning owner. High weights preferred. NOTE: This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be (1)High weights (Scale of Weights and Sex Allowances Considered); (2)Highest 2004 earnings. Footnotes

ADDED EDGE stalked the pace from along the inside, bid along the rail in upper stretch, continued on gamely as COACH JIMI LEE came in and leaned into him through deep stretch then prevailed by the narrowest of margins. COACH JIMI LEE stalked the pace racing two and three wide, moved to challenge outside PERFECT CUT nearing the stretch, edged clear, dug in gamely then came in late and leaned on the winner nearing the wire while just missing. PERFECT CUT moved clear in the early going to set a solid pace racing out from the rail, resisted when challenged in upper stretch but came up empty in the final furlong. STORMY IMPACT stalked the pace from three wide and lacked a late closing response. FREEFOURINTERNET saved ground while dropping well off the early pace, rallied through the far turn to angle four wide into the lane but could not threaten the top ones late. KODEMA stalked the pace racing three to four wide and failed to offer a bid.
