Footnotes

LIEPERS FORK made the pace on a short lead inside THIRD MUSKETEER, shook free in upper stretch and moved off under steady handling. CROWN MYST broke inward to bump hard with a rival, moved up four wide on the far turn and held the place late. GOT BRASS floated out on the first turn, stalked the pace from three wide to bid through the far turn and could not sustain the effort. PAY CHECK saved ground off the early pace, angled five wide into the stretch and moved up to narrowly miss third. REASONABLE CAT angled six wide into the stretch and improved position while not a threat. HAMMER DOWN HANK stalked the pace from three wide and tired. THIRD MUSKETEER pressed the pace outside the winner to late in the far turn and gave way. PARISKY was bumped hard at the start and was always back. BRAVE 'N AWAY bore out over rivals heels on the first turn, dropped out and was eased.
