**Footnotes**

CITY PRAYER showed good early speed to cross over and gain the inside going to the first turn, made the pace on a clear lead then came out from the rail through the lane and lasted from the run of AMERICAN STRIKE late. AMERICAN STRIKE settled outside off the early pace, rallied four to five wide through the far turn into the lane and closed but could not run down the winner. MISS DAN PAT tracked the pace racing three wide to move nearest the winner on the far turn then weakened in the lane while holding third late. S TABLE DANCER stalked the pace racing four to five wide and lacked the needed late response. PASS THE LUCK was out from the rail in reach of the pace to upper stretch and tired. BEBOPPING GOLD saved ground and was not a factor. KAYLEE BAILEY was outrun racing outside. BRUNSWICK SUE tired racing along the inside. SCHOOL BELL saved ground and was outrun. MISS MARKER chased the pace of the winner while out from the rail, came to the rail into the lane, gave way and was eased late.
