Footnotes

BULBRUSH stalked pace to turn from rail, angled out for the drive and rallied to be along in time. ITSA HOLIDAY away alertly, dueled early, drew clear into the stretch but was outfinished late. CALL IN ADVANCE close up to force the pace, loomed boldly at the eighth pole but hung in the late stages. OAK RICH never far back, rallied widest into the stretch with a mild late gain. COOSA RIVER never far back, raced evenly but lacked a late response. MAX'S PICTURE THAT never far back, floated five or six wide around the turn with a mild gain. THOUGHT I COULD was through after a half. SLICK TOWN MONKEY was no factor. PL'SHARD KNOT was through early. WESTERN BANDIT stumbled and unseated rider at the start.
