Footnotes

LOVE THIS TRICK was unhurried while saving ground, came into the lane with good momentum and a wide open rail, remained on the inside and drew away inside the sixteenth pole. LATIN NOTE raced in the three path through the turn, angled to the two path inside the eighth pole and was up for place. TYPHOONIGATOR tracked the pace along the inside through the turn, swung into the five of six path for the drive and was up for the minor share. HAARMAN pressed the pace three wide into the lane then weakened inside the sixteenth pole. OAK RICH was in the four path through the turn, fanned into the six or seven path for the drive and moved up while not a serious threat. WALLSTREET CHARLIE stalked the pacesetters four wide into the lane then weakened. SOLON EXPRESS set the pace into the lane while under pressure then gave way through the lane. BRASS BOLT raced four wide through the turn, was steadied near the three-sixteenths pole when another took his path then lacked room late. ZYGLLOW raced five wide through the turn then tired. LORI'S LITTLETRICK was outrun near the rail.
