MALIBU RUN settled back off the pace racing out from the rail, moved four wide into the lane to bid through midstretch and moved off under steady urging. LULU KIMBALEE was on the pace from outside SEEYAATTHEFINISH, edged clear on the far turn then could not offer no resistance to the winner while holding second late. CHEROKEE PLAY stalked the pace racing two to three wide to bid inside lane but had no late response. TRY HARD GAL saved ground and lacked a late bid. SEEYAATTHEFINISH was on the pace from inside LULU KIMBALEE to late in the far turn and tired. GO LAUREN reared to miss the break badly then was always back racing wide. TRICKY CITY stalked the leaders from three or four wide to the far turn and tired. STONEY SWEET gave way from four wide. LILY STORM lunged and broke outward at the start and was always outrun.
